

CONFERENCE AND BOARD MEETING COST EQUALISATION

The cost equalisation scheme was adopted at the 1981 Conference and is intended to cover the cost of Conference and Board meetings. These costs are the responsibility of Areas.

The cost equalisation scheme is based on the actual costs of Conference and Board meetings, adds CPI for the previous financial year and divides that by the number of participating Areas.

Areas not contributing to the cost equalisation scheme cannot be seated at Conference, however Areas experiencing difficulties can be given special consideration at the discretion of Management Group.
